



Trekanten is a popular meeting place in Asker. The area is known for its good atmosphere, thanks to its pleasant squares and outdoor dining in the summer season.

The selection of shops and other services, including health services, is wide and the shopping centre has parking space for 800 cars. Every week approximately 80,000 customers visit Trekanten, of which 87% say they would recommend the shopping centre to others.

Trekanten has emerged as a natural extension of the pedestrian street and city centre shops in Asker, as well as the adjacent cultural centre and cinema.
